Laminates get touch of drama

ADDING unexpected colour and pattern in kitchen bench tops and feature walls is a great way to create drama and interest in a home, according to Jared Dinneen, Laminex marketing manager.

As part of Laminex Fusion DesignSource, which provides pre-created designs that can be made into laminate surfaces, a new range "This Life", has been created by renowned textile designer Julie Paterson,

and "can turn an ordinary space into an extraordinary experience," he says.

Inspired by everything from graffiti on inner-city walls to the gum tree down the end of her street, Julie says she has gathered together 10 themes that reflect "everyday Australian experiences".

"It is the strength, austerity and scale of the Australian environment that inspires me; the tones, the textures and the patterns

are a never-ending source of stimulation," she says.

Urban living and the natural world are explored in bold geometric prints and subtle earthy tones, Julie says, with some designs featuring bright flowers, kangaroo grass, coral and cafe chalk boards.

Julie's designs can be represented on laminate and used for tabletops, wall panels, ceilings, cabinetry and more, says Jared.
